

Logic Model: Show Me (How to Get) the Money! Barbara Gottschalk

1. **Problem Statement:** Let's empower teachers to see grant funding for the good ideas they want to implement.

Goal: To create a linked network of teachers interested in seeking grant funding to enhance teaching and learning.

Rationale:

Do you need money to fund your good ideas? This idea can help individual teachers get the grant support they need.

Inputs: →

- 1. Attendance at three conferences this spring.
- 2. Twitter
- 3. Digital platform
- 4. Google site posting

Activities: →

- 1. Collect contact information
- 2. Send out mass email
- 3. Build up list of contacts
- 4. Set up website
- 5. Talk with district IT people for support

Outputs: →

- 1. Website
- 2. List of contacts
- 3. Resource page online

Outcomes:

Short Term:

- 30 Days →
- 1. Website (Google)
- 2. Twitter activity

Medium Term:

- 60-90 Days →
- 1. Group list of participants

Long Term:

- 90 Days and Beyond
- 1. Interactive discussion board up and running for reviewing proposals, sharing information, etc.
- 2. Participants gain funding for their good ideas.

External Environment: Participant buy-in

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
